- eligibility criteria will be excluded from the selection process. If additional verification is required beyond the documents listed above, further documents may be requested.
- **5. Important Notes** - A standard admission certificate will be issued only to those who have passed

the document review and have paid the full tuition fee.

- For expected high school graduate, a graduation certificate must be submitted by February 27, 2026. Failure to submit the certificate by the deadline will result
- in disqualification. - Tuition payments can only be made in Korean Won (KRW), and refunds will
- also be processed in KRW. The student is responsible for any exchange rate differences and fees incurred from using an overseas account.

- Admission and acceptance will be canceled for those who have falsified, forged,

or altered documents, or engaged in any other fraudulent activities.

- For foreign students, admission and enrollment will be canceled if there are any disqualifying reasons for changing the visa (D-2) status before the start of the semester.
- In the event of admission cancellation, only a portion of the tuition fee will be refunded in accordance with the regulations.
- In the case of foreign students, if the tuition fee is not paid, they will be considered unregistered and expelled. If they withdraw, only a portion of the tuition fee will be refunded in accordance with the regulations, and they must return to their home

country within two weeks(Failure to return will result in illegal stay).

- For foreign students, if taking a leave of absence, they must return to their home country within 2 weeks(Failure to return will result in illegal stay).
- Foreign students are required to enroll in the National Health Insurance and pay a monthly insurance premium to the National Health Insurance Service.
- For foreign students, a specific amount of scholarship will be provided in accordance with the university's scholarship program.
