### 2. Eligibility Requirements

Applicants must be foreigners whose both parents hold foreign nationality, and who have graduated (or are expected to graduate) from a domestic or foreign high school. (This is recognized only if both the parents and the applicant acquired foreign nationality before the applicant began an educational program equivalent to the Korean high school curriculum.)

All of the following eligibility requirements and details must be satisfied.

<b>Nationality</b>	Foreign nationality (Parents and Applicants)	If the applicant or either of the parents holds dual nationality, application will not be accepted.
<b>Education</b>	Graduated (or expected to graduate) from a regular high school, either in Korea or abroad	The qualification recognition date for prospective graduates is February 27, 2026.(For countries where the academic term starts one month later than in Korea, such as Japan, an exception allows for up to one additional month of enrollment.)

- ※ Documents written in a foreign language must be submitted along with the original and a notarized Korean translation.
- ※ Verification of enrollment and academic records for regular high school courses completed in Korea must be submitted via the student record (School Life Record).
- ※ If the English name on the submitted documents is different, submit a certificate of identity issued by the court or a diplomatic mission official from the relevant country.
- ※ Applicants who do not submit documents within the deadline or do not meet the eligibility criteria will be excluded from the selection process.
- ※ If additional verification is required beyond the documents listed above, further documents may be requested.

### 5. Important Notes

- A standard admission certificate will be issued only to those who have passed the document review and have paid the full tuition fee.
- For expected high school graduate, a graduation certificate must be submitted by February 27, 2026. Failure to submit the certificate by the deadline will result in disqualification.
- Tuition payments can only be made in Korean Won (KRW), and refunds will also be processed in KRW. The student is responsible for any exchange rate differences and fees incurred from using an overseas account.
- Admission and acceptance will be canceled for those who have falsified, forged, or altered documents, or engaged in any other fraudulent activities.
- For foreign students, admission and enrollment will be canceled if there are any disqualifying reasons for changing the visa (D-2) status before the start of the semester.
- In the event of admission cancellation, only a portion of the tuition fee will be refunded in accordance with the regulations.
- In the case of foreign students, if the tuition fee is not paid, they will be considered unregistered and expelled. If they withdraw, only a portion of the tuition fee will be refunded in accordance with the regulations, and they must return to their home country within two weeks(Failure to return will result in illegal stay).
- For foreign students, if taking a leave of absence, they must return to their home country within 2 weeks(Failure to return will result in illegal stay).
- Foreign students are required to enroll in the National Health Insurance and pay a monthly insurance premium to the National Health Insurance Service.
- For foreign students, a specific amount of scholarship will be provided in accordance with the university's scholarship program.
