2. ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS

Applicants must be foreign nationals whose parents both also hold foreign nationality, and must have graduated or be expected to graduate from a high school in Korea or abroad. This eligibility is valid only if the applicant and both parents acquired foreign nationality before the applicant began an educational program equivalent to the Korean high school curriculum. All of the following eligibility requirements and details must be satisfied.

5. IMPORTANT NOTES

- **X** Additional Guidelines:
- All foreign-language documents must be submitted with the original and a notarized Korean translation.
- For high school records completed in Korea, submit the School Life Record.
- If the applicant's English name differs across documents, submit a Certificate of Identity issued by a court or an official from the relevant country's diplomatic mission.
- Applicants who fail to submit required documents or meet eligibility criteria will be excluded from the selection process.
- · The university may request additional documents if further verification is needed.

5. IMPORTANT NOTES

- A standard admission certificate will be issued only to those who have passed the document review and have paid the full tuition fee.
- For expected high school graduate, a graduation certificate must be submitted by February 27, 2026. Failure to submit the certificate by the deadline will result in disqualification.
- Tuition payments can only be made in Korean Won (KRW), and refunds will also be processed in KRW.

 The student is responsible for any exchange rate differences and fees incurred from using an overseas account.
- Admission and acceptance will be canceled for those who have falsified, forged, or altered documents, or engaged in any other fraudulent activities.
- For foreign students, admission and enrollment will be canceled if there are any disqualifying reasons for changing the visa (D-2) status before the start of the semester.
- In the event of admission cancellation, only a portion of the tuition fee will be refunded in accordance with the regulations.
- In the case of foreign students, if the tuition fee is not paid, they will be considered unregistered and expelled. If they withdraw, only a portion of the tuition fee will be refunded in accordance with the regulations, and they must return to their home country within two weeks(Failure to return will result in illegal stay).
- For foreign students, if taking a leave of absence, they must return to their home country within 2 weeks (Failure to return will result in illegal stay).
- Foreign students are required to enroll in the National Health Insurance and pay a monthly insurance premium to the National Health Insurance Service.
- For foreign students, a specific amount of scholarship will be provided in accordance with the university's scholarship program.
