Degree Programs



1. 1. Program Overview : These programs lead to an associate degree. Depending on the department, students may also continue to earn a bachelor's degree after completing the associate program.

2. Eligibility Requirements for International Applicants (Document Screening 100%, Total 120 Points)

Nationality	Applicants and their parents must all be non-Korean nationals. (Applicants and parents holding Korean citizenship in addition to another nationality, as well as stateless persons, are not eligible.)
Academic Requirements	 Must have completed 12 years of primary and secondary education equivalent to the Korean education system and have graduated (or be expected to graduate) from a high school in Korea or abroad. For those expecting to graduate, the qualification recognition date is February 28, 2026. (Exceptionally, applicants from countires where the academic year starts one month later than Korea (e.g., Japan) will be recognized within a one-month enrollment period.
Language Requirements	 Applicants must meet at least one of the followng criteria: 1. Hold TOPIK Level 2 or higher. 2. Complete Level 2 or higher Social Integration Program (KIP) or obtain a pre-evaluation score of 41 or higher. 3. Complete Level 2 of the Sejong Korean language Assement (SKA). 4. Complete at least one year at Baewha Korean Language Center and pass the center's assessment equivalent to TOPIK Level 2.

X Applicants must meet all nationality, academic, and language requirements.

※ All international degree students receive a first-semester entrance scholarship and a continuing scholarship each semester. Students with TOPIK Level 3 or higher receive an additional scholarship.

- Students will develop Korean language skills for daily communication and gain an understanding of Korean culture.
